



MRS. BASINSKI'S KINDERGARTEN STUDENT SUPPLY LIST

This is your child's KINDERGARTEN SUPPLY LIST. Please take a few minutes to familiarize yourself with what your child will need. These supplies should be brought to school **NO LATER THAN THE SECOND DAY OF SCHOOL**. Please feel free to bring some or all of these supplies with you when you attend the kindergarten parent informational meeting. Thank you for **putting your child's name on each item**. Crayons, markers, and pencils **should be individually marked with initials** for quick identification. Thank you for all your time, effort, and assistance in gathering and supplying these items.

1. 1 box of 16 count (at least) CRAYOLA crayons
We insist these be CRAYOLA crayons, so each child has consistent color names printed on each crayon for reading purposes. CRAYOLA crayons are also lead free.
2. 1 pair of scissors
Please make sure your child can cut and manipulate the scissors of your choice. They should be comfortable and work with ease.
3. 1 box of 100 count, 5 ounce, Dixie cups
4. 1 water color paint set
5. 1 art smock
6. 1 – 8 ounce bottle of ELMER'S white glue
7. 4 Elmer's Washable Glue Sticks (.77 oz each)
8. 1 large box of tissues
9. 1 rug or blanket (No sleeping bags, PLEASE)
10. 1 –12 count pack of SHARPENED colored pencils
11. 12 SHARPENED no. 2 pencils
12. Crayola colored markers – Please select package containing **primary colors**
13. 1 container of Clorox disinfecting wipes (35 wet wipe count)
14. 1 school supply box, approx. 12 x 5 (2-3" deep), Sterilite brand (11½ x 7 x 2¾) works well.
15. 1 sweater or sweatshirt (to be left at school)
16. 1 extra pair of sneakers (to be left at school for emergencies or if your child forgets their shoes.) **Our new gymnasium floor requires non-black soled athletic shoes.**
17. A COMPLETE change of clothes placed inside a large ziplock bag and labeled "EXTRA CLOTHES FOR _____"
18. \$5.50 for "Weekly Reader" subscription for the year. Please put this money in an envelope with your child's name and label it Weekly Reader
19. 1 school backpack/book bag (must be brought to school each day)
20. 1 folder for take home papers. This folder is an important line of communication between home and school. Your child must bring it to school each day. **Please examine your child's work and remove it on a daily basis, allowing the folder to be clutter free.**
