

## Brief testimonials by a few parents whose children attend CCA (as shared during the spring of 2009)

### ***Joy, public school teacher and mom of 3 CCA students:***

“The first thing that just blew me away when I had my kids started at CCA was the amount of love coming from the teachers toward my children.
